Elected committee members serve as a voice for American Indian students and families within the more than 70 schools that make up the Minneapolis school district. To be eligible to serve on this elected committee, you must identify as at least ONE of the following:

- Parent/legal guardian of an American Indian MPS student
- Be an MPS American Indian student in good academic standing (current 8th-11th, 9th- 12th Grade next year)
- Be MPS teacher or staff member April 1, 2022
- Be a community member interested in advocating for students and families educational experience in MPS

- Green Central will be a Before School Late program for the **2022-2023** school year, which is \$15/day.  
- Families can register at Lyndale for after school care, which will be \$14/day.
- There is a 2 day/week minimum, and families do need to pick a consistent schedule.  
-With the current AM program they just select a number of days a week and can show up whenever, which is not the case for Mpls Kids.
